SUMMARY OF CURRENT SITUATION AND ACTIONS

- The reopening of County Parks, Marinas and Golf Courses has proceeded with no reported issues.
- All beaches remain closed. The Miami-Dade Parks beaches at Crandon Park, Haulover Park, and the atoll pool beaches at Matheson Hammock Park and Homestead Bayfront Park remain closed. Zoo Miami is closed.
- Miami-Dade Animal Services (ASD) is hosting a drive-through Pet Food Bank on Thursday, April 30, from 8:00 AM to 11:00 am (or while supplies last), at the Pet Adoption and Protection Center in Doral, located at 3599 NW 79 Avenue, Doral, FL 33122.
- The Florida Department of Health has reported that, to date, there have been 11,927 positive cases in Miami-Dade County.
- Miami-Dade County currently has three hundred seventeen (317) COVID-19 related deaths.
- 2,318,533 meals have been delivered to seniors since March 16, 2020. Today, 84,799 meals were delivered.
- The Florida Department of Health published reminder on Washing Your Hands (Attached).
- The Miami International Airport reported a 71% reduction in Flight Operations (Passenger, Cargo & General Aviation) in comparison to the same time period last year.
- A non-cellulose N95 mask decontamination unit will be deployed to Hard Rock Stadium. Decontamination will be available to government entities, hospitals and community based testing sites at no cost. Each eligible entity must sign a service agreement. Interested entities should begin gathering masks for shipment. The anticipated start date is April 30, 2020.
- The Miami-Dade County webpage www.miamidade.gov/coronavirus contains the County's most current information on Coronavirus, as well as links to the latest news from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the FDOH.

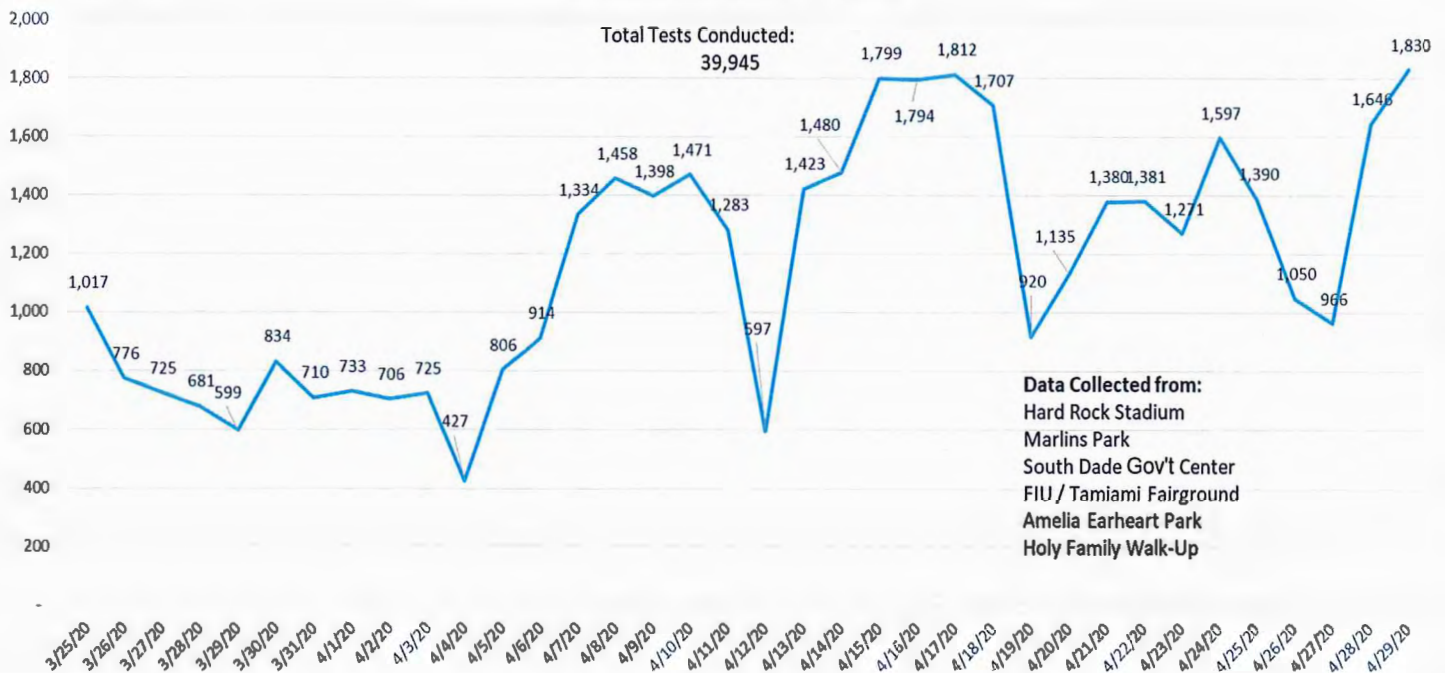

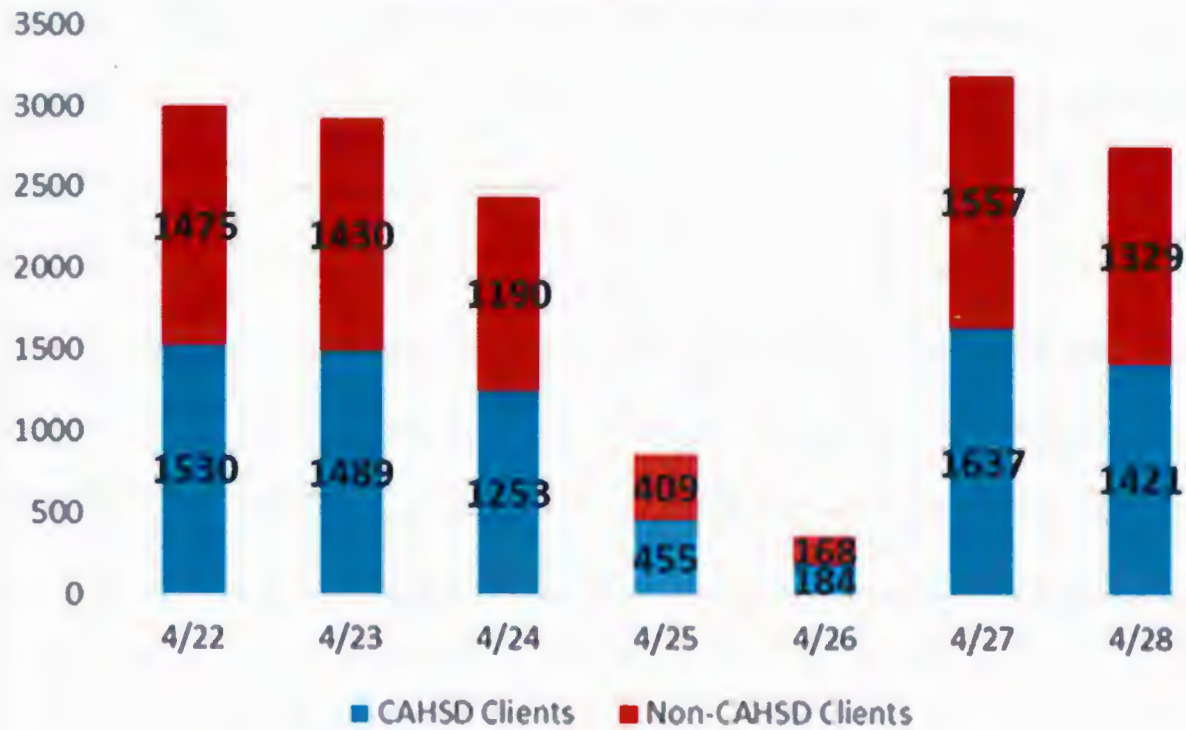

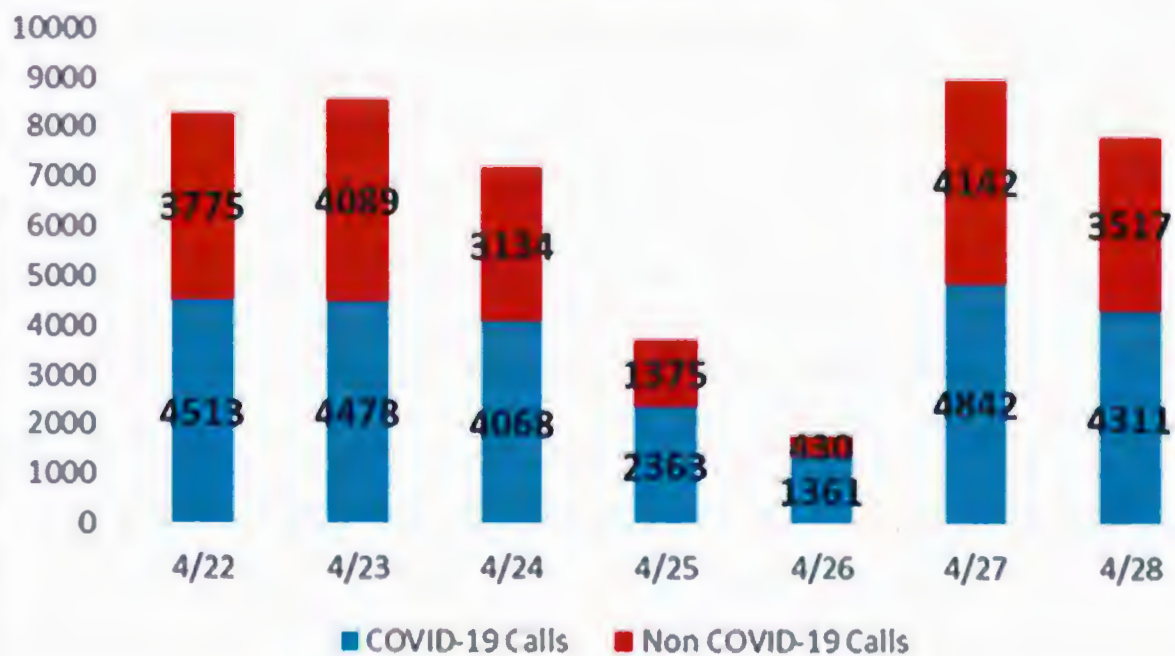
Collection Sites Total Tested

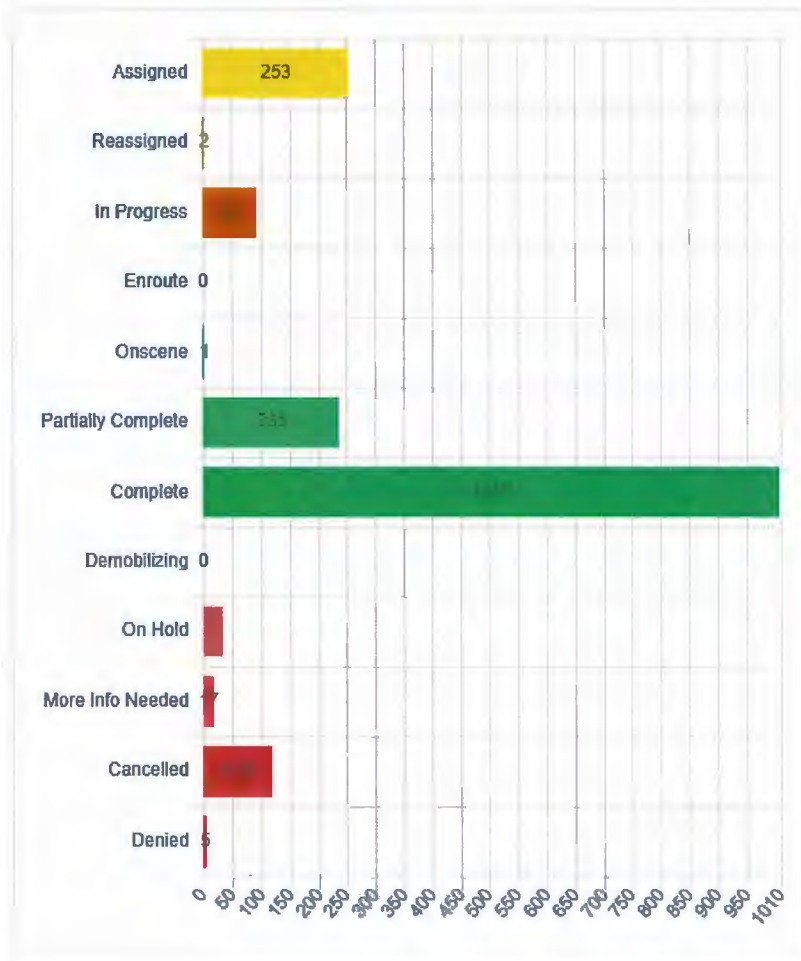

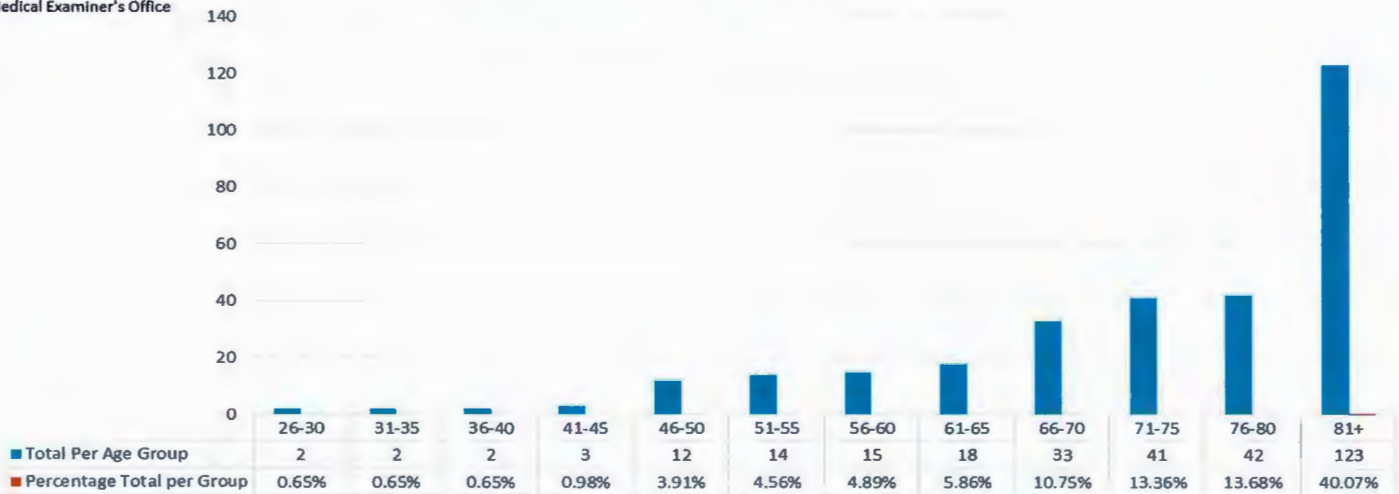

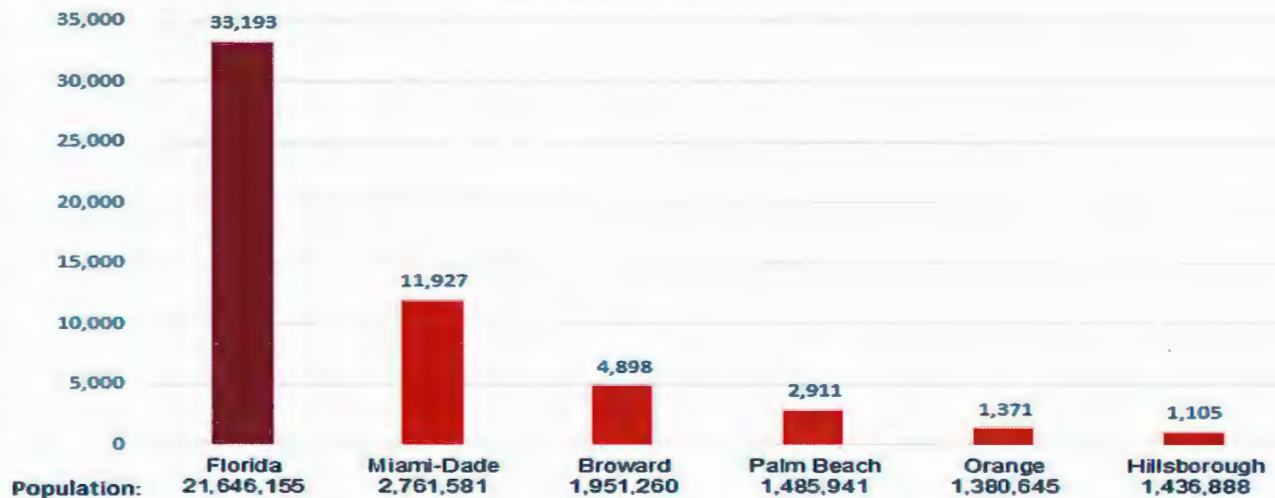

Miami-Dade County Deaths as of 4/28/20

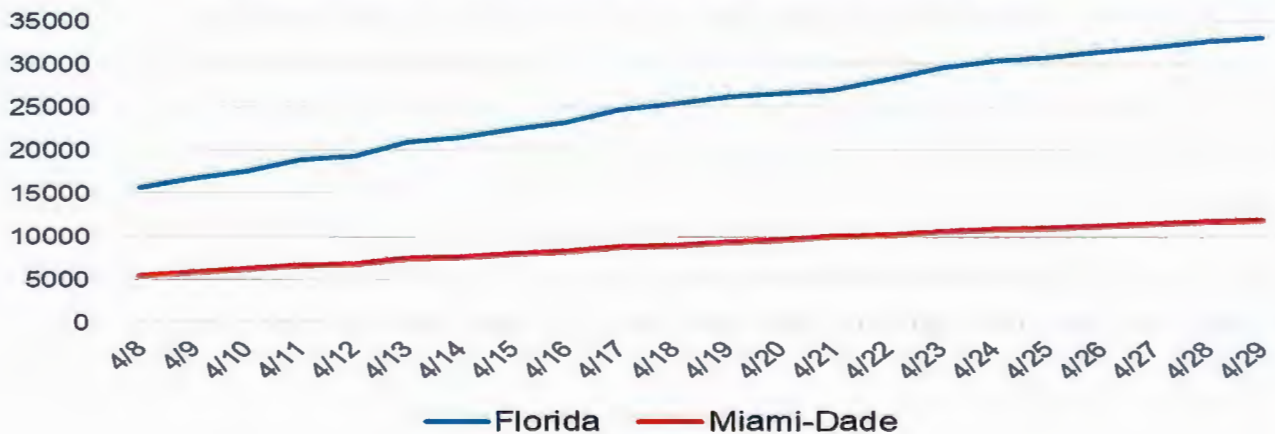


Florida & 5 Counties with Most Cases
4/29/20 at 12:00 PM

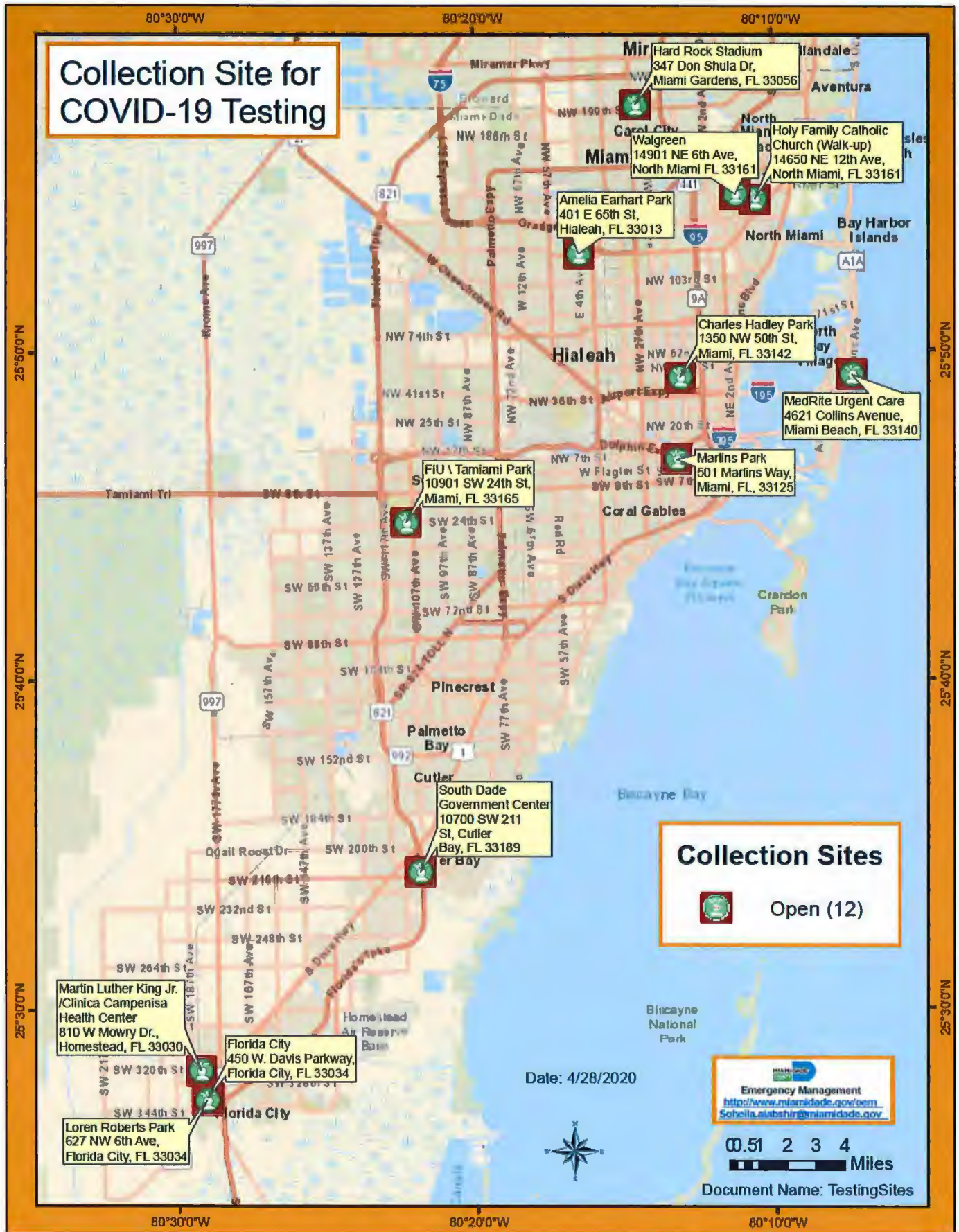

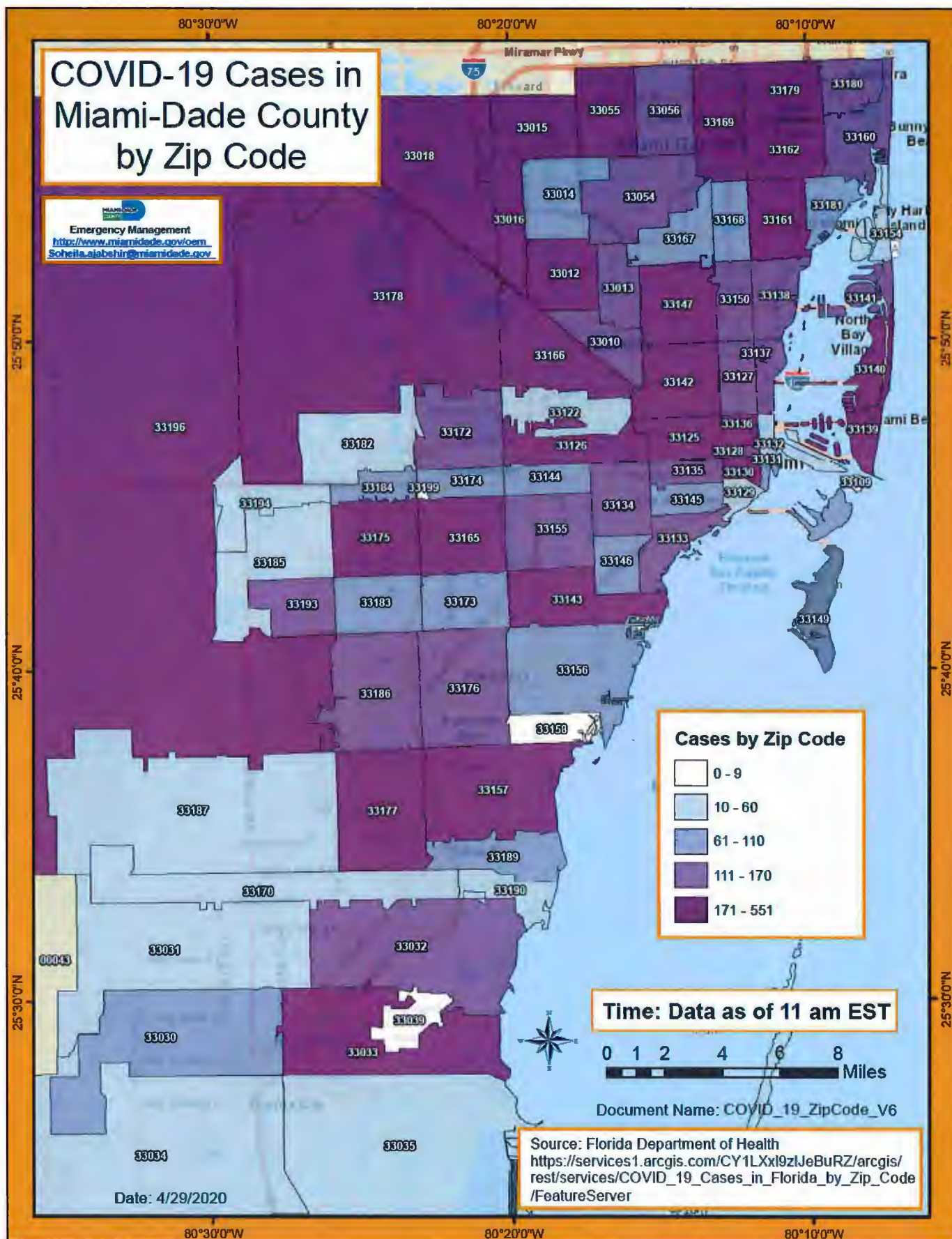
Cumulative Florida and Miami-Dade Cases



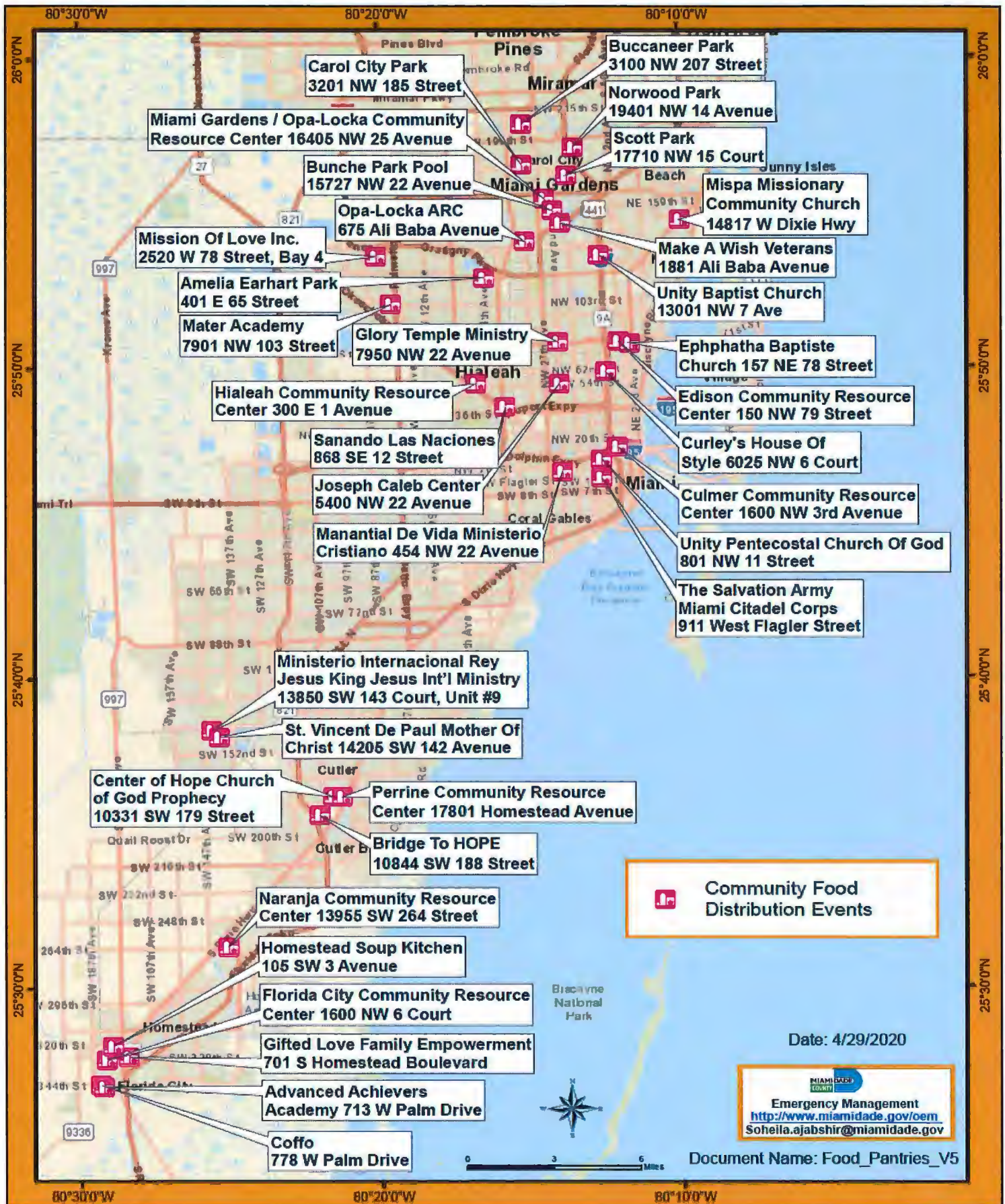

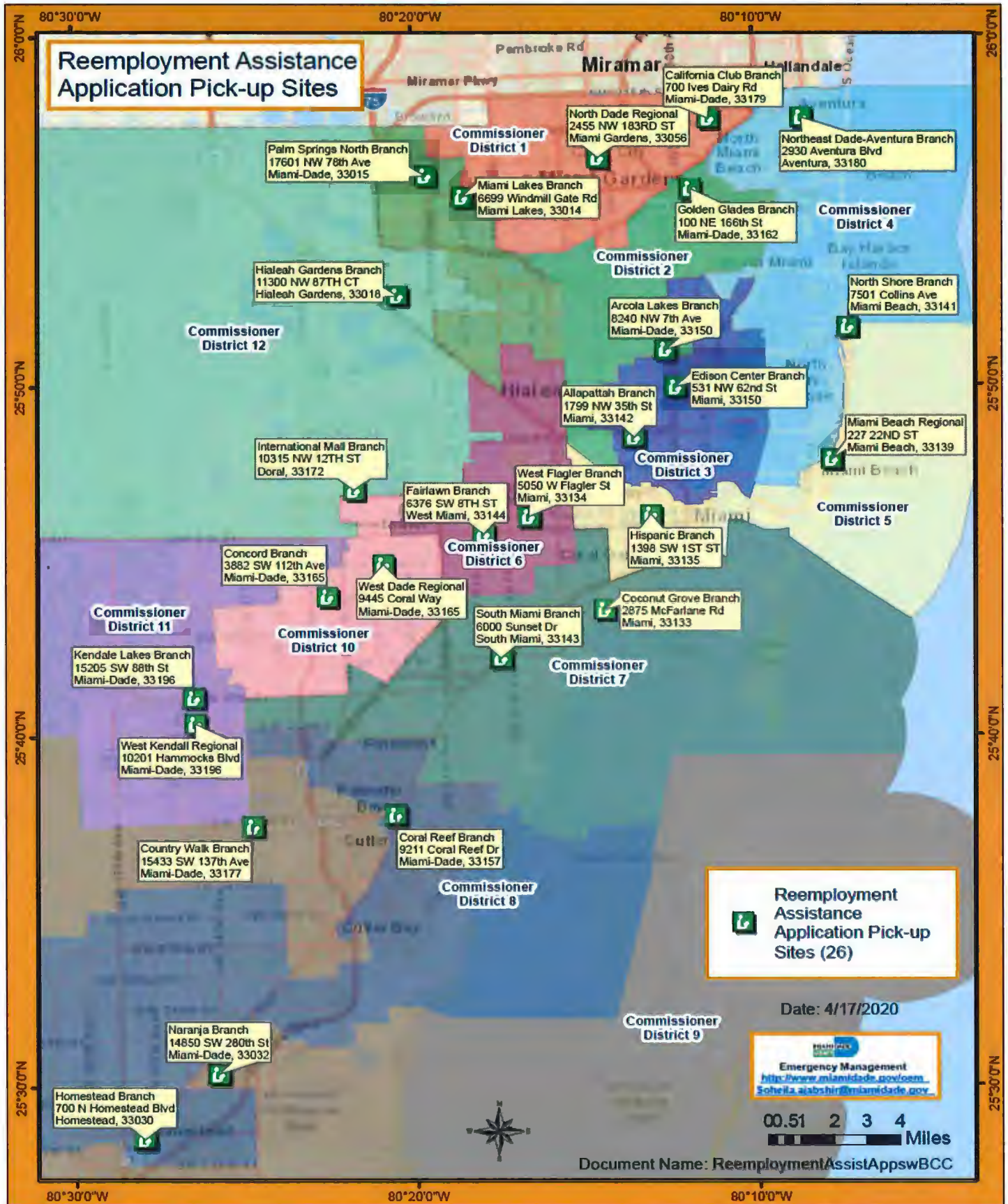
COVID-19 CASES IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY BY ZIP CODE
